



Agency Case Study: Huntsville Police Department (AL)

A Multi-Year Partnership Elevating Firearms Performance Across the Department

Overview

In 2021, Guardian Training & Consulting Founder and Director of Training **Josh Logan** began a professional relationship with the **Huntsville Police Department** after meeting with their **Rangemaster and training staff**. That meeting led to a **3-day custom course for HPD’s Special Operations Group (SOG)** and opened the door to ongoing collaboration focused on enhancing performance-based firearms training at all levels of the agency.

Since then, Guardian has returned to Huntsville **multiple times** to train patrol officers and tactical units using our IADLEST-Certified course, *Shooting at the Speed of Efficiency – Pistol*, as well as a customized 1-day rifle/pistol course for their SWAT team, and an upcoming 2-Day Vehicle Combatives Instructor Development Course.

Note: “Shooting at the Speed of Efficiency – Pistol” is available in both 4-hour and 8-hour formats to meet agency needs.

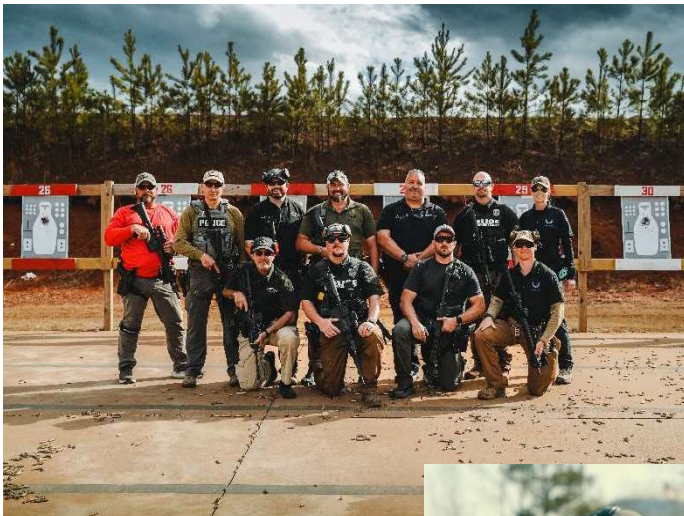
